**Swimming Pool / Water Park**

The only municipal pool in Johnson County is located in Tecumseh and was built in 1964. The pool is not ADA compliant and is in constant need of costly repairs. The City has been mandated to install a lift to accommodate swimmers that may need assistance entering the pool and this must be done by March 2012. Council members have debated several options for saving the pool, but these options still involve restoring a 46 year-old pool, which at best, is temporary, as eventually we will need to become compliant with all the regulations regarding public swimming pools. Your donation to this project would be set aside for a new pool and water park that could be enjoyed by the entire region.

**Fire Hall**

The Tecumseh Volunteer Fire Department recently merged with the Tecumseh Rural Fire District, in part, to partner on the construction of a new fire hall. The land for the new fire hall has been donated and financial donations are being sought to help with the costs associated with designing and building a new hall. The present fire hall was built in the '40's and was not designed to handle the weight of the trucks now being stored there. Your donation would help fund this worthy project.
