The City Council of the City of Tecumseh, Nebraska, met in special session in the Utilities Conference Room at the Utility Shop on the 21st day of July, 2014 at 5:00 o'clock p.m., in a publicly convened session, the same being open to the public and having been preceded by advance publicized notice, a copy of the same being annexed to the minutes of the meeting as Attachment #1, said attachment showing how the availability of an agenda of then known subjects was communicated and the time and specific place of the holding of this notice, the same having been transmitted to each Council Member simultaneously. The Mayor presided and the City Clerk recorded the proceedings.

### **Routine Business**

Mayor Montz read a statement of availability of current copy of Open Meeting Act. The following Council Members were present: Charles Murphy, Larry Carmine, Jim Philippi, Jesse Grof. Absent: Kim Jansen.

Others present: Bruce Dalluge, Jim Seckman, Kevin McKinney, and Ann Curry.

Jim Seckman and Kevin McKinney spoke to the Mayor and Council about a proposed event with music and a beer garden to be held in Tecumseh on August 8, and asked that the City allow the Tecumseh Volunteer Fire Department to serve beer in a designated fenced-in area and approve blocking the street for this event. Motion by Councilmember Murphy, seconded by Councilmember Grof, to approve blocking 4<sup>th</sup> Street between Clay and Broadway and allow alcohol to be served inside the fenced-in area in front of the Fire Hall from 4:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. Yeas: Carmine, Philippi, Grof, Murphy. Nays: None. Absent and not voting: Jansen. Motion carried.
