The City Council of the City of Tecumseh, Nebraska, met in special session in the Utilities Conference Room at the Utility Shop on the 28th day of July, 2014 at 5:00 o'clock p.m., in a publicly convened session, the same being open to the public and having been preceded by advance publicized notice, a copy of the same being annexed to the minutes of the meeting as Attachment #1, said attachment showing how the availability of an agenda of then known subjects was communicated and the time and specific place of the holding of this notice, the same having been transmitted to each Council Member simultaneously. The Mayor presided and the City Clerk recorded the proceedings.

### **Routine Business**

Mayor Montz read a statement of availability of current copy of Open Meeting Act. The following Council Members were present: Jim Philippi, Charles Murphy, Larry Carmine and Kim Jansen. Absent: Jesse Grof.

Others present: Kristen Brase, Paula Darling.

There were no changes to the original posted agenda.

### **Regular Agenda**

City Clerk Darling went through the proposed revenue and expenses for the city budget, including capital improvements and debt service. The Council agreed that the pond project would not be pursued due to the lack of interest by the County and Fair Board and that those expenses should be deleted from the proposed budget.

Motion by Councilmember Murphy, seconded by Councilmember Philippi, to approve an across the board 3% wage increase for all full/part/temporary/seasonal city employees, including the city clerk, code enforcement person and the city attorney, and a 3% increase for Utility Employees Nikki Mason, Maxine Watteyne, and Ann Curry. The new park position will start at \$10.50 per hour. Yeas: Murphy, Philippi, Jansen, Carmine. Nays: None. Absent and not voting: Grof. Motion carried.

On motion the meeting was adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
